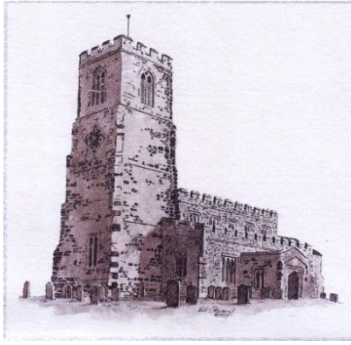


FRIENDS OF SUTTON CHURCH (FOSC)



Welcome to our 100+ club

The Friends of Sutton Church ("FOSC") is a registered charity (293616), whose purpose is to preserve the structure of our ancient village church. This is the 6th year of our 100+ Club. Please join to help support our village church!

Here's how it works:-

- Membership costs **£12 per annum**
- **6 draws per year**
- **First Prize is 25% of all proceeds, Second Prize is 15%**, 60% of the proceeds will be retained by FOSC to help repair and maintain All Saints Church, Sutton
 - For example, if there were 100 members,
 - First Prize is 25% of £200 = £50,
 - Second Prize is 15% of £200 = £30
- The draw will take place at the Sutton Village Hall coffee morning, which take place on the 2nd Saturday of every other month.
 - **The first draw will be 8th August 2026**
- If you win, a cheque will be posted to your home address and the name of the winners will be published on the Sutton Village Hall website under the FOSC section
- All participants must be over 16.

100+ club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100+ club is to raise funds for FOSC. The money will be paid into the FOSC bank account and used to meet funding requests from the Church for repairs and maintenance to the church building.

Rules

1. For a cost of £12 per annum you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100+.
2. Membership will run from 1 August to 31 July.
3. A draw will be made every other month with a 1st and 2nd prize.
4. The annual prizes will total 40% of the annual income.
5. The prize income will be apportioned as: 1st prize 25% and 2nd prize 15%.
6. The 100+ club is a private lottery and is open to all friends (supporters) of FOSC. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
7. Numbers are limited to four per household.
8. Payments can be made by electronic transfer, annual standing order or cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
9. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
10. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
11. The draw will be made on alternative months at the Sutton Village Hall coffee mornings.
12. The winning cheques will be posted to the address on your membership application within two weeks of the draw.
13. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the Sutton Village Hall website.
14. The 100+ club will be run by the FOSC. In case of any dispute the decision of the FOSC committee is final.
15. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100+ club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid on 25th July before the new annual membership period.
16. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into FOSC funds after six months.
